Players being selected to AA teams will be contacted immediately after the draft.

U11A and U13A SOUTH SIDE DRAFT

For players that ARE NOT SELECTED to AA teams they will take part in a U11A or U13A southside draft. Coaching staffs from KC, Elks, Neebing, Norwest and Westfort will be drafting teams together to try to make teams of equal skill, with full rosters. Players must be prepared to be drafted to any of the five southside organizations. Emphasis for the southside draft is to create fair and even teams while ensuring roster sizes are full. This in turn helps to keep the additional team fees down per player as well as creating a competitive division of play. Players will be utilizing all rinks in the Thunder Bay area for practices and games no matter where they are drafted to.

U7 AND U9

Players in these age groups will register with their association of their choice and remain there for the entire season. In order to run programs efficiently, some associations may choose to work together to maximize available ice and fill available roster spots. Season start times and groupings will be provided by the end of September

REGISTRATION IS NOT CONSIDERED COMPLETE UNTIL FEES ARE PAID.

After each team is drafted Individual Teams will collect additional funds for the year to cover additional Team Related Expenses, such as Practice Ice, Tournaments, Team Jackets, Team Functions, etc. Amount will vary by team.

ROWAN'S LAW
